

## **LOST/FOUND PADDLE BOATS, CANOES, RAFTS, ETC.**

The Board does not want to haul off and/or destroy your paddle boat but has no option when it is discovered adrift with no identifying marks which would enable it to be returned to the owner. A boat that is partially sunken or adrift becomes a very serious hazard that could endanger children.

**Please mark your boat with your house number and street abbreviation code.** Self-adhesive numbers and letters are available at hardware stores. Community Group has already adopted the following abbreviations for our streets as follows:
